### Step 1.)

Please watch the <u>entire</u> FroKnowsPhoto Guide to DSLR Video guide (along with the bonuses) and create a list of all the questions you have. Wait until you finish the entire program so that you have your list of unanswered questions ready. (some of your questions might be answered later in the guide so we ask that you watch the whole thing first)

## Step 2.)

Send your questions via email to **dsIrvideo@froknowsphoto.com** - please use ONLY this email address for your mentorship questions.

Use "Guide to DSLR Video Questions" as the subject line of the email. Please use this <u>exact</u> subject line so we don't lose track of your email and can answer all of your questions as quickly as possible. Also, please be sure to <u>use the same email address</u> you used when purchasing the guide otherwise we might not be able to validate your account.

## Step 3.)

One of the best ways we can help you is to critique your videos. To submit a video please upload it to YouTube and share the link with us in your email. If you do not want the video public for everyone to see on your channel simply make it "unlisted." This means only people you send the link to will be able to view it.

### Step 4.)

Please allow up to 48 hours to receive an individualized answer to your questions from Jared and Todd. Due to the sheer volume of emails we both receive each day, failure to follow these directions may cause your email to become "lost" and unaccounted for.

If you do follow these instructions, Todd and I will provide a quick and detailed response to any question you have about DSLR video.
